THE COLD WAR BEGINS

How Did it Start?

- O US and USSR allies during WWII
 - **0** US = Democracy, capitalism
 - **O** USSR = Communism
- Only 2 superpowers after WWII
- O Had different political & economic ideas
- O Both sides worried about the other spreading their influence





The US's Plan


- 0 1947: GB unable to help Greece and Turkey
 - O Afraid countries will fall to communism
- OUS President announces the Truman Doctrine
 - O US will help any country fighting a communist takeover
 - O Begins US's role as the "world's policeman"





US's Plan (cont.)

- O US began the Marshall Plan
 - O Gave economic help to European countries
 - O Rebuild economies so they don't fall victim to communism
- 0 1949: NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organization) created
 - O GB, FR, US, CAN, and other Western European countries
 - O Agreed to defend each other against attacks



MARSHALL PLAN AID TO EUROPE, 1948-1952

The USSR's Plan

- O Gained land during WWII (Nazi-Soviet Pact)
- O Converted countries taken from GER to satellite states
 - O Satellite state = ind. countries strongly influenced/controlled by a larger country

1953: Stalin dies → Khrushchev takes over


- 0 1955: Created the Warsaw Pact
 - O Formal alliance b/w USSR and satellite states
