Before the Revolution...

- France needed \$\$\$\$!!!
 - Country in MAJOR debt
 - King Louis XVI added to debt by helping in American Rev.
- France had an unequal society:
 - 1st Estate = clergy (church)
 - 2nd Estate = nobility (rich)
 - 3rd Estate = everyone else (mostly poor)



How it Started

- #1: the King called the Estates General (meeting of 3 estates)
 - Each estate only gets 1 vote
- #2: the 3rd estate made the National Assembly
- #3: the 3rd estate made the Tennis Court Oath
 - Promises to write a new constitution






It is a Revolution!

- (July 1789) Storming of the Bastille
 - Rumors spread that guards were coming to Paris
 - People break into the prison for weapons
 - Sparks the revolution!



Chaos Continues!

- (Oct 1789) March on Versailles
 - Women upset with food shortages
 - 7,000 march to king's palace
 - King, queen taken prisoner
- (1791) Constitution created
 - King's power limited
 - Must follow the constitution
 - FAILURE! King is unwilling to share power





Reign of Terror & The Directory

- (1793 94) Reign of Terror
 - Led by Robespierre
 - Kills counterrevolutionaries
 - Beheads King and queen
- The Directory
 - Robespierre is killed
 - New govt. controlled by 5 directors who share power
