"The Forgotten War" Also known as "Fatherland Liberation War" in North Korea

WWII: WHAT WAS KOREA UP TO?

- 1910 1945: Korea part of Japanese empire
- After Japan's surrender:
 Korea under control of UN
 - Peninsula split at 38th parallel
 - North = trusteeship of the USSR
 - South = trusteeship of the US
 - No one asked the Koreans what they wanted





WAR BEGINS




- North = communist; leader Kim II-Sung (dictator)
- South = anti-communist; leader Syngman Rhee (dictator)
- Both sides wanted to re-unify the country under their own govt.
- 1950: North Korea invaded South Korea
 - USSR & China supported North
 - NK helped Communists during Chinese Civil War
 - UN supported South (US made up 90% of UN's forces)






Korean War (1950 - 1953)



June 25, 1950 Sept. 14, 1950 Nov. 25, 1950 July 27, 1953

COURSE & RESULT

- 1951 1953: Fighting led to a stalemate
 - War of attrition = attempt to defeat an enemy by wearing them down
- July 1953: Armistice (cease-fire) is signed
 - Country remained divided at 38th parallel
 - Established the DMZ (Demilitarized Zone) along the border
- ✤ Approx. 1.2 million died
- Tensions still remain high 62 years later
