
Germany, Italy, and Japan's quests for Empires THE ROAD TO WWII

GERMANY

- 1933: Germany builds up military
 - Violates Treaty of Versailles
- 1934: Signs 10-yr. nonaggression pact with Poland
- 1936: Puts military on shared border with France
- 1936: Supports Franco in Spanish Civil War
- 1936: Signs pacts with Italy and Japan



GERMANY (CONT.)

- 1938: Adds (Annexes) Austria (Anschluss), Sudetenland, and Czechoslovakia
 - Believes Germans need more "lebensraum" = "living space"
- Aug 1939: Nazi-Soviet Pact
 - Hitler didn't want to fight a war on 2 fronts (like in WWI)
 - USSR agrees not to fight Germany in exchange for land
- Sept 1939: Invades Poland = WW2 BEGINS!!!

ITALY

- Italy suffers from a weak gov. and economy after WWI
- 1919-1923: Mussolini organizes Italy into a Fascist state
- 1926: Negotiates for territory in Somaliland, Libya
- 1935: Invades Ethiopia
 - Violates League of Nation; nothing happens to Italy





ITALY (CONT.)

- April 1939: Annexes Albania
- May 1939: "Pact of Steel" w/ GER
 - Had to give military support immediately if war broke out
- 1940: Enters war alongside GER

JAPAN

- After WWI: Japan was seen as a world power
- 1929: Great Depression hits Japan
 - Countries can't afford Japanese goods
- 1930's: Emperor Hirohito increases nationalism, military
 - "Japanese fascism"

1937: Further invasion of

1941: Attack on Pearl harbor
